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Measure O

Is marijuana really coming to our community, legally? What you need to know about what's going on with the legalization of pot in our city.

- Measure O was repealed Feb 2018 and our city is operating under three ordinances.
- It can be smoked in public, however there are restrictions. A few of them being within 1000 ft of any school, playground, daycare, or area purposed for minors to name a few.
- Outdoor cultivation is prohibited within all zoning districts.
- The city started accepting applications in April of 2018 for commercial cannabis activity (i.e dispensaries). They will continue to accept until June 25th.

* The Veranda Heights new housing development brought to Verdemont by Beazar Homes is set to debut Fall 2018. The construction of the model homes is scheduled to begin June.





* Verdemont will finally see the old gas station located at 5928 Palm Avenue renovated. We spoke directly to Miller Architects and were advised that the plans to add a drive-thru restaurant have been changed. It will now be a brand name gas station (TBD) and a roll-through car wash. Construction will begin July at the soonest.

The Verdemont Community Center

The current Verdemont Community Center has been closed down and will now be demolished due to the amount of repairs being too costly. The
